MHCL 2022 is organized by the Department of Material Handling, Constructions and Logistics, Faculty of Mechanical Engineering, University of Belgrade, Serbia together with Engineering Design and Logistics Engineering, Vienna University of Technology (TU Wien), Austria. The area of MHCL is gaining a new momentum at the beginning of 21st century. Modern handling and logistics systems and machinery employ today advanced technologies that require deep interdisciplinary expertise for successful implementation. The conference will host a variety of contributed and invited plenary papers.

Since 2009, MHCL Conference has been organizing a **Special Session E**: *Maritime and Port Logistics* (MPL), which plays a vital role in the global transportation systems. The first Special Issue focuses on MPL has been published in the *Journal of Mechanical Engineering* (SV-JME, 59(9), 2013), providing a selection of 7 papers, among 13 papers that were presented during MHCL 2012 (the Belgrade conference). The Second Special Issue relates on MPL was published in the *Maritime Business Review* (MABR, 5(1), 2020), providing a selection of 6 papers, among 42 papers that have been presented during MHCL 2019 (the Bar conference and Wien conference). The Proceedings of the MHCL 2019 contains 42 papers of the Special Session: *Maritime and Port Logistics* (the Bar conference and Wien conference). Since 2017 the Special Session E: *Maritime and Port Logistics* has been organized as the First Part of the MPL on MHCL 2017 in Belgrade (the Belgrade conference) and as the Second Part of the MPL on MHCL 2017 in Bar (Montenegro, 16th – 18th November 2017, the Bar conference). In the same way, the Special Session E: *MPL* has been organized as the First Part of the MPL on as the Second Part of the MPL on MHCL 2019 in Bar, Montenegro (the Bar conference) and as the Second Part of the MPL on.

This year the MPL special session, with the theme of *The Time Factor in Maritime and Port Logistics*, will be organized as two parts again:

- 1. Belgrade (Serbia) from 21st to 23rd September 2022, The First Part of the MPL Physical attending, and
- 2. Bar (Montenegro) from 14th to 16th December 2022, The Second Part of the MPL Hybrid Conference.

About Montenegro

Montenegro is a country in Southeastern Europe on the Adriatic Sea. It borders Bosnia and Herzegovina to the north; Serbia to the east, Albania to the south and Croatia to the west. Montenegro has an area of 13,812 square kilometres and a population of 678,901. Its capital Podgorica is one of the twenty-three municipalities in the country. Cetinje is designated as the Old Royal Capital.

The country's name derives from Venetian and translates to "Black Mountain", deriving from the appearance of Mount Lovćen when covered in dense evergreen forests. The native name Crna Gora came to denote the majority of contemporary Montenegro only in the 15th century.
